1828-1903

The death of Mrs. Andrew Neilson, Sr., occurred at the family home on the Sybille, last Sunday morning at 2:00 o'clock. Mrs. Neilson was recently suffered with dropsy, and her advanced aged made her readily succumb to the disease.

The deceased was 75 years of age, she was born in Scotland where she was married to the husband who survives her. They had spent over fifty-five years together in happy companionship.

Mr. and Mrs. Neilson left their native hearth and settled in Pennsylvania shortly after their marriage, and there they resided until fourteen years ago when they came to Wyoming to live. They were the parents of nine children, Andrew and Duncan Neilson of the Sybille, and Robert Neilson of Morgan, Wyoming. The other children living reside in Pennsylvania.

Funeral services were held Monday at the house, conducted by Rev. J.W. Moore, of the Wheatland Congregational church, and the remains were laid at rest in Wheatland cemetery.
