

NELSON, SVEN JOHN
1852-September 24, 1938

S.J. Nelson, 86, pioneer resident of Wheatland flats, died at his farm Saturday afternoon, September 24 from a heart attack. Mr. Nelson had been ill for the past two years, although his condition was not considered serious. The body was found by Paul Freihauf, who farms the Nelson place.

Mr. Nelson was born in Sweden in 1852 and came to America at the age of 21, settling in Clinton, Iowa. He later moved to New Raymer, Colorado and came to Wheatland in 1892 where he was married to Miss Christina Nylander. He was preceded in death by Mrs. Nelson and one son, Raymond.

Surviving are six sons, Edward and Charles H. of Wheatland, Arthur of Sacramento, California, William of Excelsior, Minnesota, Gus of Mountain Home, Idaho and Emil; two daughters, Mrs. Harold Duffy of Wheatland and Mrs. Harvey Peake of Payette, Idaho; one sister, Mrs. Eva Mason of Odgen, Iowa besides other relatives and friends.

Funeral services were held Tuesday afternoon from the Copley Funeral home with Rev. L.W. Flenner officiating. Interment was made in the local cemetery.
