Funeral services were held for Dorothy G. Nettles June 20 at the United Church of Christ, services by Dr. James Vuocolo. She died at the Platte Co. Memorial Hospital June 17 following a long illness. Interment was in the Wheatland Cemetery. Arrangements were handled by the Platte Funeral Chapel.
