April 5, 1916-September 8, 1958

John Nickel was born April 5, 1916, in Minatare, Nebr. and passed away about Sept. 8, 1958. Mr. Nickel was found dead in his bed at home Wednesday noon, and an autopsy revealed he died of natural causes.

He was the son of Jacob and Lydia Calle Nickel and for seventeen years was a crane operator at the U.S. Navy Yards in California. He returned to Wheatland about a year ago to make his home. He was affiliated with the Lutheran church.

Services will be held Saturday, Sept. 13 from the Trinity Lutheran Church at 2:00 p.m. with Rev. John Kuntz officiating. Pallbearers will be Grady Karriker, James Wilhelm, Ernest Kittell, Chester Nickel, Fred Goetz and Adam Goetz.
