Funeral services for Glen Nixson, 83, who died in Wheatland on May 5, 1985 were held Tuesday, May 7 at 10:30 a.m. in the United Church of Christ with Father Kale King officiating.

Glen Nixson was born August 7, 1901 in Pawnee, Missouri, the son of Ebenezer and Emma Nixson. He was reared and educated in high school in Bethany. After graduating he attended the University of Missouri at Columbia then came to Wyoming to teach school. He taught in country schools in Goshen County then farmed for a couple of years. He worked in a grocery store in Torrington for a short time prior to moving to Wheatland to start his own retail grocery business in 1928. He operated the O.P. Skaggs Store here during his career, later changing the name to Nixson's Super Market. He retired in 1965. He was a member of the Wheatland Masonic Lodge, Scottish Rite, Shrine, Lions Club, Chamber of Commerce and after his retirement he served as a director of the First National Bank in Wheatland.

He is survived by his wife Ann; his son, Jack; one sister, Nellie Yates all of Wheatland; and three grandchildren.

Besides his parents he was preceded in death by a sister, Elvin Mitchell.

A memorial in his name has been established to the Platte County Memorial Hospital.

Burial was in the Wheatland Cemetery.
