

Leo Glenn Norris

November 2, 1925 – March 11, 2006

Memorial services for Leo Glenn Norris, 80, will be conducted at 10:30 a.m., Thursday, March 16 at First Christian Church in Wheatland, with Pastors Andy Gudahl and John Johnson officiating. Inurnment will be in the Wheatland Cemetery.

He died Saturday, March 11, 2006, at Platte County Memorial Hospital in Wheatland.

Leo was born Nov. 2, 1925, in Wheatland, the son of Irene L. (Sadler) and Claud Norris.

He was reared and educated in Wheatland, graduating from Wheatland High School in 1943.

Leo married Virginia T. Woolsey on Sept. 15, 1943, in Wheatland. He farmed and ranched west of Wheatland, retiring in 2000. Leo enjoyed fishing and hunting. He was a member of First Christian Church, Wheatland Co-op Association where he was a past president, and a board member with the
