

NORVELL, WALTER THOMAS SR
September 25, 1887-September 7, 1964

Walter Thomas Norvell, a retired farmer, succumbed in Memorial Hospital in Cheyenne on Sept. 7, 1964, after an illness of one week. The deceased was born in Krinkiska, Russia on Sept. 25, 1887 to Ralph and Tessie Norvell.

Prior to moving to Platte county in 1942, he resided at the 2 Bar ranch at Morrill, Nebr. from 1916 to 1918; farmed near Henry, Nebr. From 1918 to 1922 then worked for the Cudahy Meat Packing at Omaha, Nebr.

Norvell and Katherine Kate Stanker were married at Omaha, Nebr. in February 1916.

Services were conducted by Father Leonard Wren at the Schrader Chapel on Sept. 10 at 10:30 a.m., with interment in the local cemetery. Serving as pallbearers were Myron Schenk, R.E. Berg, Manual Rodriguez, J.E. Bohmont, John Merbach, and Harry Linton.
