Services for Minnie Eula Noyce, 92, who died March 11 in Douglas were held at the Schrader-Prell Funeral Chapel at 10 a.m. Friday, March 15 with Pastor Delbert Dick officiating.

Noyce was born Sept. 26, 1892, in Stockton, Kans., the daughter of Charles and Lucy Green. She and Irvin Noyce were married Oct. 18, 1914 in Kansas. In 1918 they moved to Walsenberg, Colo., then in 1924 to Wheatland where Mr. Noyce was a missionary of the American Sunday School Union.

He died in 1978 and in 1982 she moved to Michael Manor in Douglas where she remained until the time of her death.

She was a member of the First Baptist Church.

Survivors include two sons: Robert Noyce and David Noyce, both of Wheatland; one daughter, Esther Haburn of Salem, Ore.; one sister, Margaret Harvaugh of Madison Lodge, Kan.; seven grand children; and four great-grandchildren.
