

O'BRIEN, JOHN

September 25, 1864-November 21, 1917

John O'Brien, of Uva, who has conducted the H ranch on the Laramie river for the last fifteen years passed away on Wednesday of this week, after an illness of several months, death being due to stomach trouble. Mr. O'Brien was 53 years of age, coming to Wyoming with his parents when only about six weeks of age.

Mr. O'Brien was one of our prosperous ranchmen and one of our most highly respected citizens, and news of his death will be received with regret by a wide circle of friends and acquaintances.

Funeral services will be held at two o'clock today (Friday) and interment will be made in the Wheatland cemetery, the services conducted under the auspices of the Masonic lodge of which the deceased was a member.

Besides the wife, Mr. O'Brien is survived by four sons, George, John Jr., Edward and Lee, and a daughter by a former marriage, Mrs. Elsie Powell of Douglas.

The deceased is also survived by three brothers, James, Edward and William of Douglas and seven sisters, Mrs. Schloss, Mrs. Curry, Mrs. Race, Mrs. Howard of Douglas, Mrs. Arnold of California, Mrs. Riley of Salt Creek, and Mrs. Sherwin of Montana.
