PARKER, STANLEY M. 1919-1928

Stanley Parker, 9 year old son of Mr. and Mrs. S.M Parker, died Wednesday evening as the result of a rattlesnake bite which happened Tuesday afternoon about 4 o'clock.

According to information received, the little boy, whose home is west of Fletcher Park, had gone to his grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. G.W. Parker, for the day and was playing with his cousins just outside of the yard when he was bitten. He ran into the house and told his grandmother a rattlesnake struck him just below the knee, in the calf of the leg. She immediately applied the tourniquet and drew out what poison she could and medical aid was summoned as soon as possible. Judging from the distance between the fang punctures on the little boy's leg, the snake was evidently very large and is probably the reason they were unable to save him.

Funeral services will be conducted by Rev. H.E. Shepherd of the M.E. church at the Watson Mortuary at 2 p.m. tomorrow, Friday.
