

Services for Ansil Myron Pensis who died in Wheatland Dec. 13, 1982 were held Friday, Dec. 17, 1982 at First Christian Church in Wheatland with Dan Barcus officiating.

Mr. Pensis was born July 24, 1915, in Hutchins, Wis., the son of John and Jennie Seymour Pensis. He moved with his family to Billings, Mont., where he was raised and attended school. He entered the U.S. Navy in 1935, was discharged in 1939, and was called back to active duty in 1942.

After being separated from the Navy in 1944 he returned to Montana where he joined the Heat & Frost Asbestos Workers Union Local No. 82 of Billings and Spokane. He worked in construction in various communities for 31 years until he retired and moved to Wheatland in September of 1981

Mr. Pensis is survived by his wife, Rose and son, John, both of Wheatland; daughter, Genevieve Brown of Three Forks, Mont.; and three sisters, Mrs. W.S. Dallas, Lucille Bettick and Mrs. S.H. Robinson.

He was preceded in death by his parents and one brother.
