

PETERSON, EDWIN CHRIS  
June 25, 1911-April 10, 1965

A short illness claimed the life of Edwin Chris Peterson at the Veterans Hospital in Cheyenne April 10, 1965. Mr. Peterson was born in Osakis, Minn. on June 25, 1911 and was a Guernsey resident for forty years. He served with the army in World War II from March 1942 to November 1945, and was a member of the Baptist church. For the past six months, Mr. Peterson had been employed as an operating engineer by Knisely-Moore Construction Co. at Wheatland.
