PIPHER, DEWEY April 15, 1899-March 4, 1939

Dewey Pipher, 40, of Sunrise was killed Saturday night, March 4, when an automobile he was driving hurtled off a bridge five miles east of Lingle and plunged down an embankment to the river bed. Mr. Pipher was returning to Sunrise with two companions when the accident occurred. He was apparently blinded by the snow storm. The other two occupants of the car received only minor injuries.

Mr. Pipher was born April 15, 1899 in Horicon, Wisconsin and moved to Wyoming with his parents in 1916. The family settled in Meadowdale and Mr. Pipher has since made his home there. On August 25, 1938, he was united in marriage to Alberta Metcalf in Wheatland and to this union two children were born, Marceline and Anna Mae.

He is survived by his widow and two children of Sunrise, his mother, Mrs. Laura Pipher, one brother, Lloyd and other relatives.

Funeral services were held Wednesday afternoon at 2 o'clock from the Watson and Dennis Chapel with Rev. Morton of Guernsey officiating. Interment was made in the Wheatland cemetery.
