MRS. W.H. RALSTON DIES AT RANCH HOME
Wife of County Commissioner Passes Away at Home Near Uva Last Friday Night

Mrs. Ralston came to Wyoming to visit her brothers, W.F. and Peter Macfarlane of Horseshoe, and on November 21<sup>st</sup>, 1892, was married to W.H. Ralston at St. Mark's church, Cheyenne. Since their marriage, Mr. and Mrs. Ralston have made their home at the ranch near Uva.
