

RHODES, ROBERT J.
March 10, 1920-January 9, 2000

Funeral services for Robert J. Rhodes, 79, were held Thursday, January 13, 2000, at 2 p.m., at the Platte Funeral Chapel in Wheatland, with Andy Gudahl, Minister of the First Christian Church officiating. Interment was in the Wheatland Cemetery.

Mr. Rhodes died Sunday, January 9, 2000, at the Platte County Memorial Hospital in Wheatland.

Bob was born March 10, 1920, at Deer Lodge, Mont., the son of Mildred (Marshall) Rhodes.

After completing high school and working a couple of years, Bob joined the United States Navy. He served during World War II from 1943-1945, receiving an honorable discharge as a motor machinist mate.

Bob worked construction jobs, moving to job sites around the country. In 1970, he married Lois Helen Klarr in Cody, Wyo.

After their marriage, they continued to move to various towns around Wyoming. In 1979 they moved to Wheatland where he worked for Basin Electric during plant construction.

After retiring, they lived in Wheatland and Thermopolis. He had recently moved to Guernsey. He was a member of the Wheatland Moose Lodge, Veterans of Foreign Wars, the Elks Lodge in Torrington and the Eagles in World. He enjoyed playing golf.

Bob is survived by a number of special friends including Esther Brown, Edie Lawrence, Tonia Golka and children, Brian Lawrence, Tom and Luetta King and family, Cliff Bouma, Gene Benson, and Gene Bachmeir.
