

Amelia Rivera
Services for Amelia Rivera, 81, were held Saturday, September 5, at 10 p.m. at First Christian Church, 95 - 19th Street, Wheatland, WY, with Andy Gudahl, Minister officiating. Interment was in the Wheatland Cemetery.

Mrs. Rivera died Monday, August 31, at the Platte County Memorial Hospital in Wheatland. Amelia was born February 14, 1917, in Chacon, N.M., the daughter of Emelio and Delphinia (Cruz) Lopez.
