ROBBINS, JESSE ?-August 4, 1914

NEWS ITEM: Relatives here have written to the coroner who held the inquest over the remains of Jesse Robbins, shot and instantly killed while at work on a ranch in Montana, and are expecting details of the death in a few days. No word accompanied the body. The bullet was evidently from a high powered gun. It penetrated the forehead just above the right eye and passed out at the base of the brain in the rear. The remains were received here Monday and the funeral took place Monday afternoon from the Fred Belcher residence in this city. Burial took place in the local cemetery. The unfortunate young man left here last spring for Montana. He was the nephew of Mrs. William Holcomb and brother of Henry and Roy Robbins.
