## Henry Otis "Hank" Roberts

February 1, 1919 - September 27, 2001

Funeral services for Henry Otis "Hank" Roberts, 82, will be held Thursday, September 27 at 10 a.m. at the Wheatland Bible Church in Wheatland with Pastor Denzil G. Mauk officiating. Inurnment will be in the Wheatland Cemetery in Wheatland at a later date.

Mr. Roberts died surrounded by his wife and several children at his home in Wheatland on Saturday, September 22, after a courageous two and a half year battle with cancer.

Henry was born February 1, 1919 at Glendo to Thomas and Hazel (Mittan) Roberts. He attended Hytrek School east of Glendo through the eighth grade. Henry worked for several ranchers before joining the United States Navy in 1942, serving for four years during World War II. He worked at CF&I Mine, for Bowen Brothers, and retired from working for the Town of Wheatland in 1983.

Henry married Wanda See in Wheatland on September 6, 1951, and to that union, five children were born and they adopted a nephew, William Earl See in 1962. After Wanda's death, Henry married Louise May (Scott) Williams on October 19, 1973, in Guernsey. Henry loved his big family, especially his grandchildren. He liked to work in his yard and garden; he enjoyed bowling with the Seniors for several years; and loved fishing and going to the mountains. He was a member of the Golden Age Club and Little Dozen Pinochle Club; and attended the Wheatland Bible Church.
