ROBINSON, FRANK WILKINSON June 15, 1877-October 22, 1948

John Wilkinson Robinson was born June 15, 1877 in Ainsley, Nebraska. He came to Wyoming in 1897 and settled on a ranch 35 miles west of Wheatland.

On Dec. 23, 1901, he was united in marriage to Frances Roe. They operated the ranch until 1943, when Mr. Robinson's health failed, and they moved to Wheatland, selling the ranch. He died October 22 in the Wheatland hospital after an illness of five days.

He is survived by his wife Frances of Wheatland; one son, Roy R. Robinson of Chugwater; five brothers, Edward and Herbert of Wheatland, Walter of Glendo, Frank of Laramie and Andrew of Boise, Idaho, two grandchildren and numerous nieces and nephews.
