

RUNYAN, ROSS HENRY
June 7, 1892-September 12, 1965

Last rites for Ross Henry Runyan, a retired merchant and auto salesman, were held at the Schrader Chapel on Sept. 14, 1965 at 2:00 p.m. with Rev. Henry Hartberg officiating. Interment was in the Wheatland cemetery.

Mr. Runyan was born in Danbury, Ia. on June 7, 1892, and was married to Cora Belle Phelps on Sept. 27, 1912 in Gering, Nebr. He was a member of the Methodist church and had lived in Wheatland since 1910. For seven of these years, he resided in Rawlins. Death occurred on September 12, 1965 in the Platte County Memorial Hospital following an extended illness.
