Mr. Ryff died Tuesday, April 10 at his home in Wheatland.

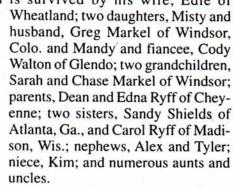

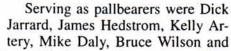
