

Services for Martha Sater, 72, who died in Cheyenne, April 30, 1986, were held Saturday, May 3, at 2:30 p.m. in the Schrader-Prell Funeral Chapel with Dan Barcus officiating.

Martha Viola Sater was born in Reynolds, Nebr., August 28, 1913, the daughter of J.E. and Louisa Black. At an early age she moved with her family to Wyoming. She attended high school in
