

SCHOLLE, FRED WILLIAM
April 20, 1860-November 18, 1922

Frederick William Scholle was born in Aurora, Ind., April 20, 1860. Departed this life, Wheatland, Wyo., Nov. 18, 1922. When a young man, he moved to Alma, Mo., where, on April 11, 1883, he was united in marriage to Miss Clara Melton.

In 1906, he removed with his family to Abbyville, Kans., where he lived until 1916, when he came to Wyoming in hopes the change of climate would benefit his health. He lived near Chugwater for three years. In 1918 he moved to Wheatland where he has since lived.

In 1885 he united with the Methodist Episcopal church. He greatly enjoyed the church services and was a regular attendant until the last year when the nature of his business and the state of his health made it necessary for him to rest on Sundays.

He was a kind father, an affectionate husband and greatly loved by all who knew him.
