Graveside services and interment for Melvin LeRoy "Lefty" Seymour, 61, were held Friday, October 13, 1995 at 1 p.m. at the Wheatland Cemetery in Wheatland, Wyoming with Reverend Brud Coy officiating.

Mr. Seymour died Monday, October 9, 1995, at the Platte County Memorial Hospital in Wheatland.

was a member of Carpenter's Union Local #469, having joined the Union in 1961. Lefty enjoyed fishing.

He is survived by his wife, Donna of Wheatland; three children, Rodney Seymour of Wheatland; DeVonna Seymour of Laramie, Wyoming; and Raymond Seymour of Wheatland; two sisters, Shirley Schomer of Phoenix, Arizona, and Donna Hannah of Whitewood, South Dakota; two brothers, Earl Seymour of Phoenix, Arizona and Warren Seymour of Pleasanton, California; an adopted sister, Lisa Mason of Gillette, Wyoming; a step-brother, Clifton Walker of Phoenix, Arizona; and seven grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his parents, step-father, Gill Walker; and sisters, Martha Verdugt and Ethel Donneworth.
