He resided in Wheatland during his retirement years. He was a member of the Wyoming Peace Officers Association, Wyoming Highway Patrol Association; and a life member of the Cody Elks B P O Lodge No. 1611. He enjoyed his family, friends, coffee buddies, hunting, fishing, reading western books, and watching western movies.

He is survived by his wife, Ilah, of Wheatland; children, Dawn Rittel and husband Brad of Douglas, Vicki Fellows and husband, Ira of Cody, and Dan Shaffer and Cindy Hopfauf of Wheatland; sisters, Betty Warrick and Gina Zouhar both of Chula Vista, Calif.; brother Roger Shaffer of Cheyenne; grandchildren, Kelly Kahler of Douglas, Mike Kahler of Laramie, Jeff Kahler of Douglas, Christi Livingston of Cody, and Rikki Lynn Bowen of Cheyenne; great-grandson, Chase Livingston of Cody; and several step-grandchildren and great-grandchildren.
