

SHUPP, ALLEN HOWARD
April 4, 1890-April 25, 1965

Allen Howard Shupp, retired farmer and former Wheatland resident, succumbed in Tampa, Fla. April 25, 1965 after an illness of one week. Mr. Shupp was born in Culberton, Nebr. on April 4, 1890 to Mr. and Mrs. William Shupp. He resided in Wheatland 1929 to 1943 and in Rawlins from 1943 to 1964 when he moved to Tampa. He was a member of the Congregational Church.

Survivors included his sons, Ralph of Sitka, Alaska, Kenneth of Laramie, Franklin of Tampa, Fla. and a daughter, Mrs. Myrna J. Sleeper, Casper; brothers, Archie and Ansen of Denver and thirteen grandchildren. His wife, Bessie Noyce Shupp, preceded him in death in 1943.

Last rites were conducted at the Schrader chapel on April 29, at 2:00 p.m. by Rev. Warren D. Dirks of Cheyenne. Burial was in the Wheatland cemetery with David Noyce, Robert Noyce, Alvin Klaseen, Clarence Locke, Denzil Blow and Cleon Rinker serving as pallbearers.
