

SIMPSON, MARGARET C. GORDON  
1872-April 5, 1959

Funeral services were held this morning (Thursday) at 11:00 o'clock for Margaret Simpson, who passed away Sunday in the Dorsett Memorial Home in Spearfish, S.D. Rev. Daniel T. Winger officiated at the graveside services.

Born in Ballymena, Ireland in 1872, she came to the United States at the age of ten, with her father, David Gordon, and homesteaded near Glendo. In 1900, she went to Denver to attend business college, later moving to Deadwood, S.D. where she was private secretary for Otto Pernell. After her marriage to Buck Simpson in 1909, they homesteaded near Hulett. She was a life-long member of the Baptist church.

Survivors are two daughters, Mrs. Bonnie Zuech, Phoenix, Ariz.; Mrs. Ila Bryant, Grants, N.M. and a half-sister, Mrs. Herbert Morrison, Yucaipa, Calif. Her husband preceded her in death in 1915.
