Martha was given a yeast starter for bread when she married in 1929; and, kept it alive until she gave it to her daughter (in its original container) in 2003. As she always made her own bread, she figured out how to convert her bread-making ingredients to a modern day bread machine.

Survivors include three children, Edward Smith and wife, Ruth of Douglas, Alice Woolsey and husband, George of Wheatland, and Wilma Hannifin and husband, Rick of Cody; a sister, Bertha Griffitts of Douglas; 12 grandchildren; 17 great-grandchildren; and 2 great-great-grandchildren.
