1872-September 6, 1950

Final rites were conducted at 2 o'clock Monday at the Church of the Nazarene for Robert M. Smith, 79, resident of the Wheatland and Chugwater communities since 1923. The deceased who was born in Eureka, Kan., in 1871, was a victim of a drowning accident Wednesday afternoon of last week when he and Arthur J. Roath, 84, were unable to save themselves when their boat overturned in the Wheatland Reservoir Number 1.
