July 25, 1910 - May 1, 2002

Funeral services for Anna Margaret Stugart, 91, were held Monday, May 6, at 2 p.m. at Trinity Lutheran Church in Wheatland, with Pastor David L. Anderson officiating. Interment was held at the Wheatland Cemetery.

Anna was born July 25, 1910, in Hauck, Russia, the daughter of George and Catharina Elizabeth (Beitnitz) Bohl Sr. The family immigrated to America, "the land of milk and honey" in October of 1911. The voyage took almost a month until the ship arrived at Galveston, Texas. Anna's sister was born soon after they arrived in Galveston and when her mother and new sister were ready to travel, the family boarded a train for Denver, Colo. Anna's father had a cousin who has immigrated several years earlier and they stayed with the cousin and his family until they could find a house and begin their lives in America. After a winter in Denver, they moved to Delta, Colo. Working in the beet fields; them to Montrose; Colorado: to Denver again and Longmont, Colorado, and then to Lovell, Wyoming for a few years. In December of 1928, the family moved to Wheatland and Anna married Alexander Stugart on December 21. 1930. They farmed in the Wheatland area, retiring in 1970, moving into Wheatland and residing there until her death.

Anna was a past member of the Farm Bureau and was active in 4-H with her children, and a member of Trinity Lutheran Church. She enjoyed cooking, gardening, and crafts.

She is survived by three sons and their wives, Neil Stugart and Joan of Wheatland, Arthur Stugart and Barbara of Cheyenne, and Larry Stugart and Pat of Fort Collins, Colorado; seven siblings, Hilda Shupp of Torrington, Hattie Burzlaff of Casper, Helen Dower of Denver, Colorado, Mary Ferrar of Thornton, Colorado, George Bohl Jr. of Wheatland, Art Bohl of Wheatland, and John Bohl of Paradise, Calif.; nine grandchildren; seventeen great grandchildren; and numerous nieces and nephews.

Anna was preceded in death by her parents; husband, Alex, on January 21, 1990; a brother, Kenneth Bohl; and two sisters, Mollie Goetz and Frieda Chase.
