STUGART, JOHN October 1, 1897-June 11, 1944

Funeral services were held today (Thursday) in the Evangelical Bethlehem church for John Stugart, 46, who died in the Memorial hospital in Cheyenne, Sunday, June 11, following an illness of two days. The Rev. J. Schoenberger conducted the services and burial was in the Wheatland cemetery.
