

SUTHERLAND, CHESTER B.
September 21, 1868-February 20, 1942

Chester B. Sutherland was born in Denver, Colorado, September 21, 1868, the son of James and Emily Boulder Sutherland, and passed away in Wheatland, February 20, 1942.

The family moved to Wyoming in 1876, locating on the Laramie river below Uva.

He was united in marriage to Clara Bettelyoun at Cheyenne on September 19, 1894. To this union were born four children: George C. of Glenrock; William I. of Wheatland; Edward R. of Cheyenne; and Mrs. Glenn W. Brown of Council Bluffs, Iowa. Mrs. Brown preceded him in death in May of 1930. He spent the greater part of his life in Wyoming.

Besides the children that survive him are three sisters: Mrs. M.L. McCormick, Mrs. Francis Reiman, Mrs. Patrick Daley and one brother, James Sutherland, and seven grandchildren.

He lived a full and happy life and enjoyed good health to within a few days of his death.

Funeral services were held in the Congregational church Monday afternoon, Rev. Flenner delivering the sermon.
