Emma Sophia Swan was born in Sweden, June 17th, 1861, and died at her home on the Wheatland flats, October 14th, 1910, at 10:00 a.m.

Death was caused from a tumor, from the effects of which Mrs. Swan had suffered

for the past four months.

She came to America in the spring of 1883 and was married to her present husband, Charles A. Swan, October 3rd, 1884. By this union she has five children living, also two children by a former marriage, namely, Hilda Sutherland, of Granite Canyon, Wyo., and Andrew Exstrom, of Wheatland, Wyo.

Mrs. Swan was not connected with any church in America, but was a member of the Lutheran Church of Sweden.

She was a true christian, and died in the full assurance of faith, having no fear of death,

only waiting the Master's call.

The funeral services were conducted Sunday afternoon at the home by Rev. J.K. Hicks, of the Methodist church and there was in attendance a multitude of neighbors and friends who came to pay the last tribute of respect and love to one who had proved herself worthy.

The interment was made in the Wheatland cemetery.
