

Pioneer resident, Gustof Swan dies

Gustof Alex Swan, son of Charles and Emma Johnson Swan, was born in Salem, Wyoming, September 29, 1893. Death occurred in the Platte County Memorial Hospital February 23, 1964 after an extended illness. Swan, a retired rancher has lived in the Wheatland area since 1900 and was a member of the VFW and served in World War I.
