

TADLOCK, MARTIN RILEY
January 27 , 1911-May 16, 1989

Funeral services for Martin Riley Tadlock, 78, were held Monday May 22, 1989, at the Platte Funeral Chapel at 10:30 a.m. with Father Kale King officiating.

Interment was in the Wheatland Cemetery.

Mr. Tadlock died Tuesday, May 16, 1989, in Cheyenne.

Martin Riley Tadlock was born Jan. 27, 1911, in Metz, Calif., the son of James and Vianna (Graham) Tadlock. He was reared and educated in Kansas. At the age of 16, upon finishing his education, he joined the Cavalry. Later he drove truck and a bus for a time.

He and Eleanor Smith were married Aug. 28, 1932, in St. Francis, Kan. In 1943 he joined the Navy and was discharged in 1945. After his discharge the couple purchased the Bosler Mercantile Store in Bosler. The operated the store until 1973. He then managed the KOA Campground for two years before moving to the Wheatland area upon retirement.

He was a member of the Masonic Lodge, the D.A.V., the V.F.W., and the Shriners. He is survived by his wife Eleanor of Wheatland, son Martin R. Tadlock, Fr., of Canton, Mich., daughter Linda Wallis of Wheatland, five grandchildren and six great grandchildren.

Mr. Tadlock was preceded in death by his parents and a brother.

Serving as pallbearers were Clyde Kelly, Gene Marker, George Bohl, Gilbert Smith, Dean Luchsinger and Carl Jensen.

In lieu of flowers a memorial fund has been established to the Shriner's Crippled Children's Hospital.
