

THOMPSON, ALMA I. MOSS
October 14, 1892-March 10, 1975

Last rites for Alma I. Thompson were held Thursday, March 13, 1975 at 2:00 p.m. at the Schrader Chapel. Rev. Elliott Graves, assisted by Rev. Clifford Paulson presided over the services. Burial was in the Wheatland Cemetery.

Mrs. Thompson passed away in the Platte County Memorial Hospital Monday, March 10, 1975 at the age of 82. She was married to Oran G. Thompson in Barnard, Missouri March 26, 1911. He preceded her in death January 17, 1968. She was born in Maryville, Missouri, Oct. 14, 1892. Mrs. Alma Thompson resided at 857 Water St. here in Wheatland. She was an active member of the Senior Citizens Group.

She is survived by one daughter, Mrs. Robert (Florence) Bibbey and one son, Richard D. Thompson, both of Wheatland; and one brother, C.E. Moss of Omaha, Nebraska. Besides her husband, she was preceded in death by one son, James, in WWII, and a daughter, Edna Mae in January, 1974.
