UNKNOWN MEXICAN MALE ?-1937

An unidentified Mexican was found about one mile east of Guernsey on the CB & Q Railroad on Tuesday where he was struck by an extra C & S freight train. The coroner at Wheatland was notified and went immediately to the scene, together with Sheriff Joe Wickam.

Examination showed the man met an accidental death, as there were not signs of violence, excepting injuries which were probably caused when he was hit by the train. He had been dead approximately six hours when his body was found.

Altho his clothing was carefully examined for identification marks, the local authorities have thus far been unable to learn his name or anything concerning him.

The man's description is as follows: Age, about 45 years, 5 ft. 2 in. tall, weight 130 lbs., black hair, brown eyes.

Burial was held this morning in the Wheatland cemetery. Watson & Dennis Home for Funerals was in charge of the case.
