

VOGT, WILLIAM  
February 20, 1872-April 30, 1959

William Vogt was born in Vermillion, Ohio, February 20, 1872, and passed away April 30, 1959, following an extended illness, at Lovell, Wyoming.

He was the son of Wm. and Mary Gurgess Vogt and a retired farmer. He was a member of the Catholic Church and was 87 years of age at the time of his death. Mr. Vogt resided in Wheatland from 1929 until 1944 at which time he moved to Lovell.

Services were conducted by Father Leonard Wren in the Church of St. Patrick, Saturday, May 5, at 10:00 a.m. and interment was in the Wheatland cemetery. Grandson and nephews of Mr. Vogt acted as pallbearers.
