

VOLPE, MARIN STEPHEN
October 7, 1907-September 10, 1968

Funeral services were held on Thursday, Sept. 12, at 2:00 p.m. in the Schrader Chapel for Marin Stephen Volpe, a resident of Wheatland for the past 31 years. He died at the Memorial Hospital on Tues., Sept. 10, after an extended illness.

Rev. James More officiated and burial was in the Wheatland cemetery. Military honors were given at the graveside. Pallbearers included Dr. James G. Allison, William R. Jones, Ned Bryant, George H. Good, J.H. Whitmore and Frank Kuehner.

Mr. Volpe was born in Italy on October 7, 1907. He was a Captain in the U.S. Army in World War II. Mr. Volpe had served as a mail carrier for the U.S. Government for 30 years.
