D.D. Wallace, formerly a leading business man and farmer of this vicinity, died Saturday, Jan. 6th, at his home in Denver.

Mr. Wallace had been, to all appearances, enjoying the best of health when he incurred a sudden attack of heart failure while shaving, and died instantly.
