WEBB, JOSEPH BATES January 27, 1862-July 18, 1944

Joseph Bates Webb, 82, pioneer resident of Platte county for the past 50 years, died of a heart attack at his home Tuesday evening, July 18, following an illness of nine weeks.

Mr. Webb was born in Brooklyn, N.Y. January 27, 1862. In 1891, he was united in marriage to Nettie Porter in Greeley, Colo., and to this union was born three children, one son preceding him in death. They moved to Platte county in 1894 where they resided on a ranch northeast of Wheatland, later moving to Wheatland.

Besides his wife, he is survived by a son, Whyde of Riverton; a daughter, Mrs. Hattie Cole of Cheyenne, and two grandsons. He was also the guardian of Miss Betty Lee Saladay who has made her home with them the past ten years.

Funeral services will be conducted in the Schrader chapel Friday at 1:30 p.m. with Rev. W.W. Maxwell officiating and burial will be in the Wheatland cemetery.
