Peter Weiss, 73 year old farmer of the Little Reservoir district, was found dead at his home Friday evening about 6 o'clock. He had employed a boy to do the chores on the farm and he was found dead by this boy. He evidently left this life peacefully as he was in a rocking chair when he was found.

Mr. Weiss had not been ill prior to his sudden demise but had complained that morning he was not feeling well but was able to be outdoors and work all day. County Coroner Jesse A. Payne was summoned but it was clearly evident that it was a case of heart failure and it was not necessary to hold an inquest.

The deceased was well known in this community as he had resided here 23 years, most of that time on his farm north of the little reservoir. He was born in Germany.

He is survived by the following children: Mrs. Mary Steele, Lamar, Colo.; Peter, Vinger, Okla.; Mathew, Arkansas City, Kans.; John of Burley, Ida.; Mrs. Helen Wakeland, Shoshoni, and Mrs. Ella Guilford of Wheatland. All the children were here for the funeral.

Funeral services were held Tuesday morning at 10 o'clock from the Catholic church with Father Bruno performing the final rites. Interment took place in the Wheatland cemetery with the Copley Funeral Home in charge of arrangements.
