He was reared and educated Wheatland and worked on various ranches before joining the United States Marine Corps serving from 1952 -1955. He continued his military service by serving as a reservist in the Wyoming Army National Guard where he served 25 years for a total of 28 years of military service. Don married Freddie Lu Searl on December 25, 1955, in the United Methodist Church in Wheatland. Early in their marriage they lived briefly in Casper, Wyoming and Denver, Colorado, before returning to Wheatland. He worked as a service technician

for White's Gas & Appliance, in construction, for Wilson Bros. Inc. and, then for the Town of Wheatland from 1971 to 1996, first as a police officer and then transferred to the city shop as the purchasing agent, retiring after 25 years. Don was a member of the United Methodist Church, American Legion, and Therapy Dogs, Inc. He was a man of many talents and enjoyed artifact hunting, collecting various items, fishing, and was a past umpire for Little League, Junior Legion, and Men's Of special baseball. interest to Don were therapy dogs and the 4-H dog training program where he was a leader until he was unable to continue due to poor health.

He is survived by his wife of almost 48 years, Freddie Lu of Wheatland; a daughter and her husband, Sage and Skip Bridger of Pompano Beach, Florida; three brothers, Richard Weldon of Olympia, Washington, Charles Rawlings of Martinez, California, and Lee Ray Rawlings of Phoenix, Arizona; his faithful companions, Winter and Woody; and numerous in-laws, nieces, and nephews.

Don was preceded in death by his parents.
