Vic White, 84 Dies Sept. 4

Victor Monroe White, 84 died Saturday, September 4, 1971 following a brief illness.

A resident of Platte County since 1914, Mr. White was born in Cheyenne on August 23, 1887. On September 7, 1908 he married Genevieve Garrett in Laramie, and six children were born to this union. He was a retired business man at the time of death and had lived in Wheatland since 1926, moving here from Chugwater. Mr. White will be remembered by many as a hard working civilian. He served as mayor for many years of both Chugwater and Wheatland in the 1940's and he served as Platte County Sheriff in 1931 and 1932. He was a member of the IOOF.

Surviving the deceased are his six children, Jack, Sam, Mrs. Robert Daly, Mrs. Martha Jess, of Wheatland, Mrs. Eva Withers, Kenwick, Wash., and Miss Wanda White, Miami, Florida; two sisters, Rose White and Addie Bamber; eight half-brothers and sisters; eleven grandchildren and nine great grandchildren. His wife preceded him in death July 9, 1969.

Funeral services were held Tuesday, September 7, at 2:00 p.m. in the Schrader Chapel with Rev. Charles Clough of Chugwater officiating. Interment was at the Wheatland cemetery with graveside services by the IOOF. Members of the Odd Fellow Lodge served as pallbearers.

Due to inquiries by friends, the family has stated that Mr. White's favorite charity was the American Cancer Society.
