## TRAGIC DEATH

Small Son of Wheatland Farmer is Crushed to Death Under Wheels PCK 4-3 of Truck

Roy, the little fourteen months old son of Mr. and Mrs. Alexander Wilhelm, met a tragic death at the farm home of his parents, two miles west of Wheatland, on Saturday afternoon, when his life was crushed out by the wheels of a truck driven by John Lipps. The truck had been used to haul beet seed and after unloading its cargo the truck started to back out. The baby was playing in the yard and was out of sight of Mr. Lipps. One of the wheels of the truck crushed out the little life almost instantly. Mr. Lipps has been almost prostrated over the sad affair and the parents are grief stricken over the tragedy.
