

YERTY, WILLIS AARON
April 29, 1872-July 19, 1936

Willis Aaron Yerty, a resident of the Guernsey and Cassa communities for the past 15 years, passed away at Guernsey Sunday after an illness of about one week.

Funeral services are being held from the Congregational church this afternoon at 2 o'clock. Rev. L.W. Flenner of that church will perform the final rites. The Wheatland Odd Fellow lodge, of which the deceased was an active member, will have charge of the services at the cemetery. The Copley Funeral Home was in charge of the funeral.

The deceased was born in Ipava County, Ill., April 29, 1872, and was 64-years, 2-months and 20-days of age at the time of his demise.

He came to Platte county about 15 years ago and made his home in the Cassa country most of the time. He had been employed by the WPA just before his death.

He is survived by his widow, Mrs. Florence Trump Yerty, and one son, Wesley, 9-years of age.
