

YOST, WILLIAM MCKINLEY  
December 13, 1896-March 14, 1976

Services were held Wednesday, March 17, 1976 for William McKinley Yost at the Memorial Baptist Church at 2:00 p.m. Pastor Bill Webb conducted the services. Internment was at the Wheatland Cemetery.

Mr. Yost passed away at his home suddenly Sunday, March 14, 1976 at the age of 79. He had been a resident here in Wheatland since 1928.

He was born in Afton, Oklahoma December 13, 1896. He married Elma M. Graham March 4, 1920 at Carthage, Missouri. Before moving to Wheatland he lived in Quepaw, Oklahoma. He served in the U.S. Navy during World War I. Mr. Yost was a retired farmer and a former Wheatland policeman.

A southern Baptist, he was a member of the V.F.W. Laramie Peak Post No. 3558 of Wheatland and at one time served as it's commander. He was also a member of the National Peace Officers Association, Inc. and a member of the Golden Age Club.

He is survived by his wife, Elma of Wheatland; four sons, Clyde of Laramie, Raymond of Wheatland, Dale of Corpus Christi, Texas and Robert of San Francisco, Calif.; one daughter, Margaret Feith of Denver, Colorado; eight grandchildren and one great grandchild.

One son, Don Yost, and four brothers and four sisters preceded him in death.

A memorial fund has been established to the Southern Baptist Church of Wheatland.
