

YOUNG, HENRY H.
September 15, 1889-April 20, 1961

Funeral services were held at the Schrader Chapel Monday at 2 p.m. for Henry Young who passed away at the Platte County Memorial hospital on Thursday, April 20. He had been in failing health the past two years. Rev. Fred Stiegemeier officiated at the services and the Masonic Lodge members of Chugwater acted as pallbearers with burial in the Wheatland cemetery.

Henry H. Young was born September 15, 1889, in Cozad, Nebr., son of Mr. and Mrs. George Young, and spent his early days near Gothenburg, Nebr. In 1916, he moved to Wyoming, homesteading near Chugwater, prior to moving to a farm two miles west of Wheatland about four years ago. He was a veteran of World War I and a member of the Masonic Lodge in Chugwater.

Survivors include three sisters, Mrs. Nellie Peterson, Gothenburg, Nebr., Mrs. Pearl Oman, San Jose, Calif., and Mrs. Mary Connerly, Palo Alto, Calif. and two brothers, Rex of Omaha, Nebr. and Frank of Albuquerque, N.M. Two sisters preceded him in death.
